Angle – The direction in which an object is held.

Bell on a jellyfish – The top part of the jellyfish that looks like a see-through umbrella that allows them to move through the water.

Brilliantly – Very bright.

Color-changing ink – Ink that looks like it changes color when you tilt it different ways.

Copper – A reddish brown color, like the color of a penny.

Creatures – Animals.

Currency – Something that has value that can be exchanged for goods or services. Sometimes people use the word “money” instead.

Distinctive – Clearly marking a thing as different from others.

Features – Parts or characteristics that are noticeable.

Raised – Lifted up.

Rough – Bumpy or uneven.

Texture – How something feels.

Thread – A thin fine line.

Unique – Special.

UV Light – UV stands for ultraviolet. This light can't be seen by the human eye, but when used can cause certain things to glow or become visible.

Watermark – A mark or picture placed into paper when it is being made that can only be seen if the paper is held up to light.

3-D Ribbon – A strip that has pictures on it, and when tilted the pictures look like they change and move.
