Anticipate – To expect or predict.

Blueprint – A master plan or design.

Bureau of Engraving and Printing – A part of the U.S. government that is responsible for printing paper money.

Butterfly migration – When butterflies fly a long distance from one place to another.

Circulate – To spread something around.

Complicated – Something that is difficult or hard.

Counterfeit – An object made to look real in order to fool others.

Currency – Something that has value that can be exchanged for goods or services. Sometimes people use the word “money” instead.

Declares – Tells or says.

Features – Parts or characteristics that are noticeable.

Federal – Having to do with the nation (United States).

Federal Reserve – The main bank of the United States. This bank is only used by other banks in the U.S. and by the federal government. The Federal Reserve makes sure that banks are a safe place for people to put their money by creating rules for all banks.

Federal Reserve Bank – One of the 12 banks around the United States that lends money and offers services to banks in their area.

Journey – Traveling a long way from one place to another.

Life cycle – The stages that something goes through over its lifetime.

Migrate – To move from one region or country to live in another.

Official – Meeting the rules set by people in control.
