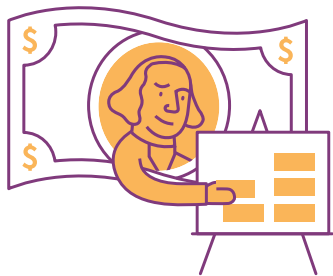


Matching Words & Definitions



Purpose of Activity

This activity is designed to familiarize students with words in the “You’d Be Surprised” currency videos that they may not have seen before. By matching a vocabulary word with its correct definition, the students will have both written and visual cues to thoroughly understand the meaning of the vocabulary words.

Concepts taught: understanding words, vocabulary, definitions, visualizing, teamwork

Materials Needed

- A set of vocabulary word cards
- A set of vocabulary definition cards
- You’d Be Surprised: Special Features video and/or the You’d Be Surprised: The Journey video [uscurrency.gov/videos](https://www.uscurrency.gov/videos)

Instructions

- 1 Print a copy of all three sets of vocabulary cards (words & definitions) for one of the currency videos for each group of students. Print and cut apart the definition cards for the same video.
- 2 Place the students into small groups of two students, and hand out the two sets of vocabulary cards to each group.
- 3 Ask each student in the group to choose one set of vocabulary cards. They may choose either the word or definition set.
- 4 Explain to the students that they will work together as a team to match each vocabulary word with its correct definition. When they are finished, ask the team to raise their hands.
- 5 The teacher then goes around to each group and makes sure their cards are correctly matched.
- 6 Show the video(s) to the students to reinforce the new vocabulary they have just learned.

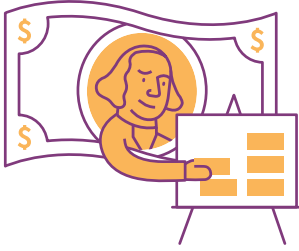
Level of Learning

Level One: The students will receive support when reading the word or definition on the cards from a peer or adult. Adults can draw pictures of the word to help the child visualize if needed.

Level Two: Follow the activity as written above.

Level Three: Once the cards are matched up, allow the children to brainstorm pictures that could represent each word.

Blueprint

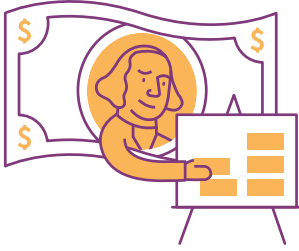
A master plan or design.

Complicated

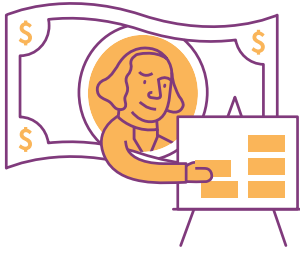
Something that is difficult or hard.

Features

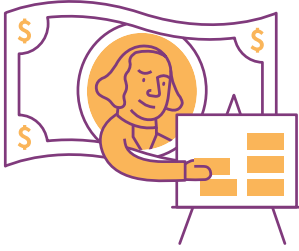
Parts or characteristics that are noticeable.

Journey

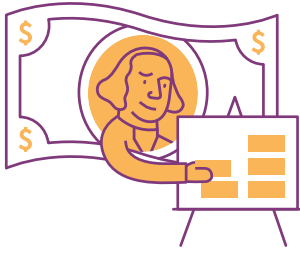
Traveling a long way from one place to another.

Official

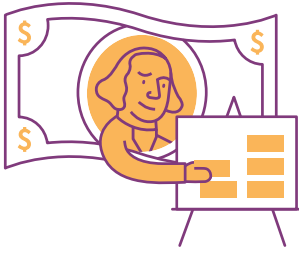
Meeting the rules set by people

Bell on a jellyfish

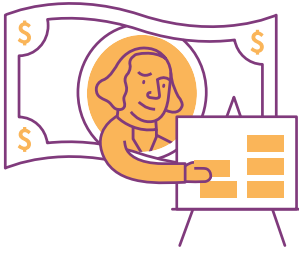
The top part of the jellyfish that looks like a see-through umbrella that allows them to move through the water.

Creatures

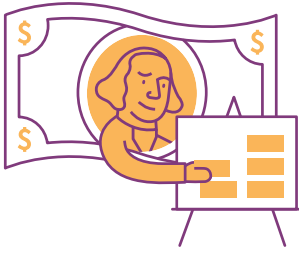
Animals.

Raised

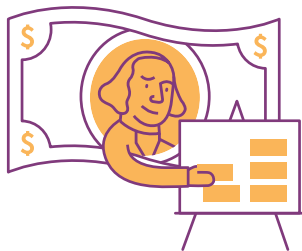
Lifted up.

Unique

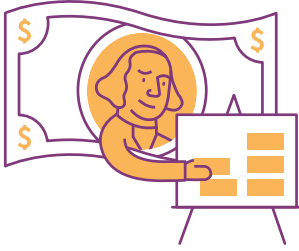
Special.
